



## Sample Recent Commissions

### Planning law and general planning advice

- **York City Council** - part-time conservation officer assisting with applications for Listed Building Consent and Conservation Area Consent, 2006-2008.
- **Various buildings and sites** - advice to numerous owners and developers on the potential for converting historic buildings and developing sites.

## Conservation Plans / Management Plans

- **King Edward VI School, Retford** - conservation plan and planning brief for redevelopment of mid 19th century school, Listed Grade II.
- **St James Building, Manchester** – conservation / management principles for early 20th century city centre office / workshop, Listed Grade II, converted to offices.
- **Ledston Hall, South Yorkshire** - input to conservation plan for Grade I Listed 13th, 16th and 17th century large country house and principles for conversion.
- **Stonecross Mansion, Ulverston** - conservation statement and guiding policies for conversion to flats of late Victorian Gothic mansion, Listed Grade II and in conservation area.
- **Danesfield House Hotel, Marlow on Thames** - conservation plan for Grade II\* Listed late Victorian country mansion, located on an Iron Age Hill fort, and as 'RAF Medmenham' the centre of Allied photographic intelligence during the Second World War.

- **Visual Arts Centre, Colchester** - Justification Statement and Impact Assessment for proposed new arts centre in conservation area and archaeologically sensitive area.
- **Scarborough Spa** – Heritage Statement for conversion / upgrading of Grade II\* Listed recreation building, as part of overall strategy to revitalise tourist resort.
- **St Andrew's Church, Kirk Ella, Hull** - Heritage Statement in support of extension to Grade I Listed Mediaeval church in conservation area, to provide meeting room etc.
- **Manchester City Airport** - Justification Statement for removal of badly altered and fire-damaged thatched cottage, Listed Grade II, to allow runway expansion.

## Support to major conservation projects

- **Liverpool docks** – conservation guidance on extension of Leeds - Liverpool Canal through north docks and across Pier Head to Albert Dock. Conservation Area / World Heritage Site.
- **Roundhouse, Derby** – design and technical advice on conversion of Grade II\* Listed complex of mid 19th century railway buildings to college of education.
- **Scarborough Spa** – design advice on conversion of Grade II\* Listed recreation building and South Bay area generally, as part of overall strategy to revitalise tourist resort.

## Condition surveys

## Technical repair and conversion
